

INTRODUCTION

The four-level series *Kids' Adventures in English* (KAE) is designed for young learners who are six and seven years old.

The objective of the series is to teach some of the basic vocabulary and structures of the English language to children who are beginning their study of English. Learning takes place through oral and written exercises, involving the development of the child's listening skills.

In KAE 4, students learn how to write the words they have learned orally. At this point in the child's development, when it is assumed that he or she has learned how to read and write in his or her own language, learning the written form of a foreign language will not interfere with the teaching of reading and writing in the student's native language. For this reason, the exercises in this book aim to develop all four language skills: listening, speaking, reading, and writing. English is used in all activities involving these skills.

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
