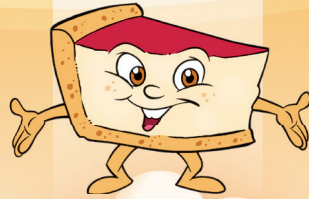

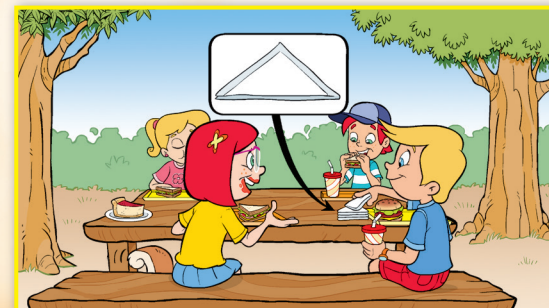


Jean: What time is it?

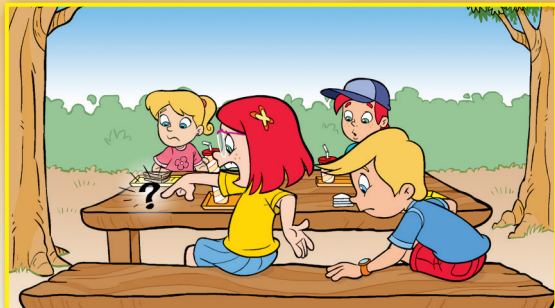
Narrator: watch



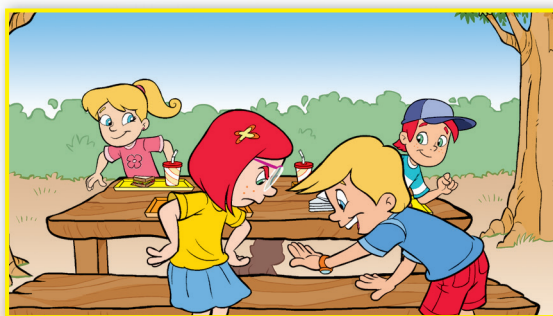
Daniel: It's twelve o'clock.

If a friend of yours did something wrong, would you feel angry of what he/she did?

Helen is angry with the squirrel and is saying, *Shame on you!*
